

Thanks for visiting.

Milda hosts my main site, Thunderchild Gallery Workshop (TCGWS). I've started reorganizing my products from the initial two years. I'm doing new products in the new process to better match Second Life (SL) and Real Life (RL) products. The oversized T-Shirt for women is the first one for this format.



The Landing point for the Milda Region and TCGWS are the same. Generally, when you land here, you will be facing east and standing in front of four portal doors. Left to right, AJ's Texture Gallery (AJTG), Bear Of Boogie Land (BOB), OFF SITE, and TCGWS. The TCGWS gets you around the parcel. Along the wall to the left are the calendars and FYI on some of the Thunderchilds. In front on the fence is the welcome information table and left to right on the fence, Rental Vendor, Job Board, two Web Browser Touch Pads (WBTP), and an online status board for AJ Leibengeist. The first WBTP will have the homepage for TCGWS in SL. The second one has info for the LGH game players. You can drop notecards in my status board. There's a horse for rezzing horses to ride around on the right towards the road.

The main spots are the Beverage Deck, the Clothes Shop, The Suns Deck for the HoloVend Clothes, and the Art Shop. You can get to each through the portal doors. Click for menu and when it brightens in a second or two, you can click to sit and be teleported.

The Beverages are my first spot because they have the complete set of artworks from the "Crash of Rhinos" represented in products there, both SL and RL. There is a set of WBTPs for each of the real-life manufacturers I use. The Punky Rooster products are on the south side of the beverages. It also has Casper Vendors and WBTP for SL and RL goods.

Second Life Products are on Casper Vendors. Real Life products are on the web browsers. Hit the double window icon in the top right corner to open the page in your preferred browser for secured transactions.

The Beverages are in the backyard. Along with some party goods, horses, and fishing. The Casper and other vendors dispense standard and adult beverages plus cannabis and psychedelic products. There are three HoloVendors there to display the products and associated Decorum products from the artwork.

The Clothes Shop is at the east end has five vendors each for men and women. The complete HUD sets are together in the middle with the seating and portal doors. The right path has women on the left and men on the right for the remain vendors. The general profiles for the vendors are...

- Women's Collections: Casuals, Dresses, T-Shirts, and Tops.
- Men's Collections: Button Shirts, Pants & Shorts, T-Shirts, and Tank tops.

You'll see WBTP on either side of the Casper Vendors. They have websites with real life products, some are matches for their SL version. There is a WBTP for each of the online clothing stores I use. Textiles are at AJ's Texture Gallery with the full permission textures.

The backyard holds my HoloVendor setup, which will be a big part of my reorganization. I've marked the men's and Women's models down on the floor for the ones I'm working with. The round center with all the women's attire is the Suns Deck. In the center is FYI and information on the set up there.

The Art Shop is about middle of the parcel. It will have displays and vendors for framed and unframed artwork. I'm revamping these products completely. In front of it you'll find my books and catalogs along with periodicals from other vendors and content providers.

The rest is support and fluff that gives me other distractions to bounce around. You can find more information from the Business Information package. My landmarks are included in the notecard. More information at my homepage at <https://thunderchild.net> .
